Neighbors are encouraged to contact ERMAS hired by Cedar Grove for real time environmental reporting and resolution of odors. They are trying to determine where the odors are generated, how they are traveling, and how to eliminate them through process changes. Cedar Grove's goal is to mitigate community impact from the facility. ERMAS is empowered to shut down operations if they find an odor causing activity and to take you to the facility to show you what is being done there. Cedar Grove is encouraging residents to call ERMAS and report odors so they have the feedback that is needed to initiate changes. Warning to residents that gas company near Cedar Grove is scheduled to come back online in 6 weeks.
